Built by ACF in 1968 as Lot #11-02692, the series 170000-170299 was the last of the covered centerflow hopper cars purchased by the GN. The hoppers carried western grain to the east to be converted into milk by Vermont dairy cattle.

It displays the Chickadee and Purple Violet flower, New Brunswick's official provincial bird and flower. The flag of the Province of New Brunswick is in the background. The road number 1867 represents the year the "Hope was Restored" province joined the confederation.

Built in February of 1960, the cars of this series proudly boast their damage free equipment with the large black and yellow circular "DF" herald. A large group of 500 cars in ran in 1960, but by 1981 the series included only 24 remaining cars.

Lettering on this car is white and it runs on UP Synthetic Red Barber roller bearing trucks. UP 169180 is one of 800 class BF-70-7, 76-ton box cars rebuilt by Union Pacific at their Albina, Oregon, shops in September of 1970. These cars were rebuilt from 40' B-50-32 class cars originally constructed in 1941 and 1942. Cars in this series are equipped with side wall lading anchors.

NEW**Burlington Northern and
Wabash Runner Packs**

These 40' standard box cars with single Superior door, bearing short ladders and no roofwalk, is painted BN green and lettered in white with a white BN logo. They were built in July 1953, serviced in June 1971 and run on Bettendorf trucks. These cars were originally built by CB&Q as part of the CB&Q 60000-60245 series and later modernized by BN with no roofwalk and numbered into the BN 161000-161899 series.

These 40' double-sheathed wood box cars with single doors and vertical brakewheels are painted box car red with large "WABASH" logo and lettering in white. They were built in September 1923 by American Car & Foundry and rebuilt by Wabash in March 1937. They roll on Andrews trucks. The cars used for the rebuildings were from two series if USRA-like double-sheathed automobile cars. They were rebuilt with 6' doors and retained the wood sides.

These black and red GP9s have white diagonal stripes on their sides with yellow reflectors and "wet noodle" logo on front and rear ends. The GMD GP9 is a 4-axle diesel locomotive built by General Motors Electro-Motive Division between January 1954 and August 1963. General Motors Diesel, Ltd., was created in 1949 as the Canadian subsidiary of the Electro-Motive Division of General Motors located in the United States. Tariffs protected Canadian manufacturers against imported goods, thus many companies wanting to do business in Canada set up controlled or wholly-owned subsidiaries in Canada.

This 50' standard box car with single Youngstown door is painted black with yellow Atlantic Coast Line logo and Another Cushioned Load lettering. It is lettered in yellow and runs on black roller bearing trucks. Built for ACL by Pullman-Standard in 1962, this car was part of series 35100-35413. By 1966, other O-35 series cars had been added and the series then numbered 35100-35899. As indicated by the "DF Loader" symbol, these cars were equipped with DF-2 loaders next to the doorways. Many cars within the series were assigned to specialized load service and equipped with pallets, side fillers and/or tote bins to accommodate those assigned loads.
