New Side Extension Gondolas!



These 40' drop bottom gondolas with side extensions are painted box car red with large white 'SP&S' letters and white stenciling. They carry wood chip loads and run on Bettendorf trucks. The Pressed Steel Car Company originally built this group of gondolas in 1948 for the D&RGW. The 1950s saw the rapid development of the paper industry in the Pacific Northwest. As a result, the SP&S began purchasing the second-hand drop bottom gondolas and adding wood side extensions to increase the capacity. They were acquired and converted between August 1964 and 1965, and numbered into the 22400-22474 series.

Pan-Am / Shippers Car Line **Road Number SHPX 66**



This three-dome tank car is painted black with white lettering and runs on Bettendorf trucks. It was built by American Car & Foundry in May 1930 for Shippers Car Line—one of a four-car order in Lot #1137. Shippers leased to the Mexican Petroleum Corporation. The three-dome tank cars were designed to carry small quantities of multiple products, such as several grades of motor oil, gasoline or chemicals to be shipped in one car. American Car & Foundry began production of three-dome tank cars in 1930 and continued through 1946.

Gulf, Mobile & Ohio Road Number GM&O 60173



This 33' twin-bay hopper with rib sides is painted black with white herald and lettering. It was built in March 1944, serviced in May 1964, and runs on Bettendorf trucks. This car was originally part of lot 2637, a 750-car build for the Alton as a war emergency composite hopper. The cars were converted to all steel in the 1950s.

This 50' standard box car with Youngstown door wears two of the experimental paint schemes, each side with MOW gray and yellow bands. The right side of the car bears the C&O logo; the other side with the Chessie logo. This car, fourth of six in the 'Cameo Car Series,' was built in May 1956 by Pullman Standard and runs on roller bearing trucks. All of the Cameo Series car designs feature varying widths of Yellow striping along with monograms and the recently adopted "Futura Demi-Bold" font.

USS Constitution Navy Series #12 Road Number IX-21



USS Constitution, known as "Old Ironsides," is a wooden-hulled, three-masted heavy frigate of the United States Navy. Named after the United States Constitution, she is the oldest commissioned ship afloat in the world. The Constitution was one of the six original frigates authorized for construction by the Naval Act of 1794 and was launched in 1797. Joshua Humphreys designed them to be the Navy's capital ships and so Constitution and her sisters were larger and more heavily armed than the standard frigates of the period.

Denver & Rio Grande Western Road Number D&RGW 14975



This black 100-ton 3-bay open hopper with coal load proudly displays the 'Rio Grande' name in white speed lettering and runs on black Barber" roller bearing trucks. This car, built by Bethlehem Steel Company August of 1966, was delivered in black with white lettering on the sides and ends. This Class HT hopper was seen working through the mid-eighties.

Canadian Pacific Road Number CP 230103



This box car red 40' outside braced box car with single door proudly displays the 'Canadian Pacific' name in white gothic lettering and runs on black arch bar trucks. When built in March of 1921, this box car had special hopper doors fabricated into the floor for grain service. The hoppers could be covered on the inside of the car to allow service as an ordinary box car. The hopper doors were removed during the 1930s. Canadian Car & Foundry, National Steel Car, Eastern Car Company and Canadian Pacific's own shops built 9,000 of these cars between 1920 and 1921.

This 40' standard box car with plug door is car #1 of a 50-car series each of the 50 states in the union. It bears the Cardinal and Violet, Illinois' official state bird and flower. The flag of the state of Illinois is in the background. The road number 1818 represents the year 'The Prairie State' was admitted into the union.

Guilford Rail System Road Numbers 52 / 54



These grey GP-9 has orange stripes and a large white circle 'G' logos. They were built in December of 1957 by the Electro-Motive Division of General Motors as part of build #7546 for Boston & Maine, which was purchased by Guilford Transportation Industries in 1983. Many of these locos were repainted during the 1990s to the Guilford Rail System paint scheme, still using the Springfield Terminal reporting marks.

These 40' box cars with single doors are painted box car red with black and white herald and white lettering. They were built by Pullman Standard in June 1947 and run on Bettendorf trucks. 



Santa Fe bought 100 tankcars from General American Transportation Corporation in 1930. These tankcars lasted into the 1970's with black paint and into the 1980's in maintenance of way service. In the late 1950's Santa Fe started painting many of these cars in Maintenance of Way White and used them in domestic water service. The one hundred cars were numbered 100800 through 100899.
