New N Scale Bay Window Caboose!



This bay window caboose is painted mineral red with daylight orange ends and bay sides and lettered in white. It was built between March and May 1980 by International Car Co./PACCAR and runs on Bettendorf Swing-Motion caboose trucks. The bay window, or side-hung cupola, debuted on the Southern Pacific Lines in 1947. They were designed in response to increasing freight car height and the resultant decrease in visibility from the cupola.

This bay window caboose is painted Conrail blue with black roof and white logo and lettering. It was built in January 1946, serviced in December 1977 and runs on Bettendorf Swing-Motion caboose trucks. This caboose was originally built for Southern Railway, acquired by Penn Central and then Conrail. Ex-Penn Central number 18438 still wears its 'as-built' class N-5H. This bay window caboose was scrapped in December 1986.

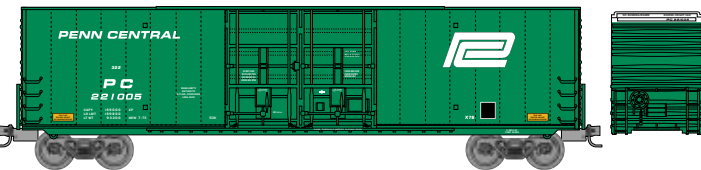

This 60' excess height box car with double plug doors and rivet sides is painted Penn Central green with white logo and lettering and black lettering on white "Excess Height" message. It was built in July 1973 by Greenville Steel Car and runs on Barber[®] Roller Bearing trucks. It is one of a small series of 20 excess height box cars that wore the large "PV" logo through the 1980s, well past the merger with Conrail in 1976.

These 40' drop bottom gondolas with coal loads are painted box car red with white logos and lettering. They were built in July 1952, serviced in September 1955 and run on Bettendorf trucks. The Illinois Central Railroad is the oldest land-grant railroad in the United States. The system encompasses 2,700 miles of freight railroad lines, traverses six states, and is the 10th largest railroad in the nation. The Illinois Central Railroad played a prominent and enduring role in the evolution of the United States.

This ACF 3 Dome Tank is white with a black belly and black lettering. Built in March 1937 by American Car & Foundry, this tank car's dome stenciling indicates it carries white oil and is equipped with heaters. It runs on black Bettendorf trucks. Union Tank Car Company is a railway equipment leasing company (and car maintenance / manufacturing). As the name says, they specialize in tank and covered hopper cars. Founded in 1866 by J. J. Vandergrift, in response to the economic activities of Standard Oil, the company has a long history. Today Union Tank Car Company is owned by Marmion Holdings and remains a dominant tank car manufacturer and service provider.

This 57' 6" TOFC Flat Car CP Action Red with a white large CP Rail logo and white lettering was built in August 1978 Marine Industries of Quebec, Canada and received its U-1 wheel inspection stencil in 1978. The star to the left of the load limit signifies that this car is not capable of carrying the maximum load permitted so the car won't be overloaded. This number cannot be changes except by the owner. CP 504485 runs on black roller bearing trucks and carries a 45' CP trailer decorated with the black, white & red "Pacman" logo.

John Tyler Presidential Car Road Number 1841-1845



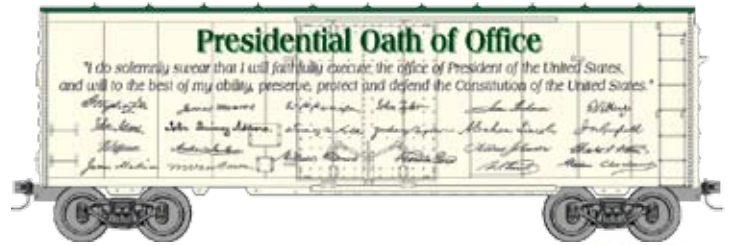
This 40' standard box car with plug door and no roofwalk is car #10 of a 44-car series representing each of the presidents of the United States. It bears the portrait of our 10th president, John Tyler. The car comes with a commemorative pin replicated from that era. Tyler has held offices in both houses of the U.S. Congress, was Governor of Virginia, U.S. Vice President as well as President. The one great achievement of his administration was the annexation of Texas.

This 50' rib side box car with single door and no roofwalk is painted green with aluminum roof and white door. It bears a green and yellow logo with green stripe and lettering on the door and white lettering on the car. It was built in July 1980 by Pacific Car & Foundry and runs on Barber® Roller Bearing trucks. Ashley, Drew and Northern is a small short line in southern Arkansas and is owned by Georgia Pacific Corp. The ADN serves 12 mills that produce paper, building products, and chemicals derived from the southern pine trees, hence the slogan, 'Serves Southern Forests'. ADN has freight connections with Frisco and Union Pacific; cars are seen throughout the country. Principal items of traffic are pulpwood and paper products. ADN was to be abandoned with the last day of operations scheduled for June 29, 1996.

This 30' box car with single door is painted box car red with white logo and lettering. It was built in June 1924 by D&RGW's Alamosa shop, CO, serviced in January 1946 and runs on Barber® Coleman Arch Bar trucks. The Alamosa system of rebuilding resulted in an almost totally new car. The system consisted of a schedule of operations whereby crews of men moved from car to car (versus moving the cars on a track) for dismantling, sorting reclaiming and rebuilding. This was a result of tax benefits for rebuilding existing equipment.

This 30' log car carries a varied log load. It has brass tie-down chains, a peacock brakewheel, runs on black Arch bar trucks and is typical of the log cars used on standard gauge railroads across the United States.

This 40' standard box car with plug door is car #12 of a 50-car series representing each of the 50 states in the union. It bears the Great Carolina Wren and Yellow Jessamine, South Carolina's official state bird and flower. The flag of the state of South Carolina is in the background. The road number 1788 represents the year the 'Palmetto State' was admitted into the union.

These GP-35 powered locomotives are painted red and aluminum with white lettering and stripes. The logo on the nose is red and black. They were built in 1963 as part of EMD order number 7668 for the CB&Q railroad. They wore these numbers and paint schemes until the Burlington Northern renumbered and repainted them after the merger in 1970.

These 40' standard box cars with single doors are painted blue and yellow with white band. The logos are red and lettering is in black and white. They were built in 1925 by General American, serviced in October 1951, and run on Bettendorf trucks. Seven hundred boxcars were taken at random from three sets of car series, among which is the series 46000-46999. In 1951 and 1952 they were rebuilt by Missouri Pacific Railroad shops at De Soto, TX, and converted into Eagle Merchandise Service.

These 40' standard box cars with single doors are painted silver and black with orange and red logos and black lettering. They were built in June 1946 by Mt. Vernon Car Co., serviced in February 1956, and runs on Bettendorf trucks. The silver "Overnights" paint scheme was adopted in late 1955; the herald was SP Daylight Orange with black lettering; the logo lettering was SP Daylight Red. The word "Overnights" was dropped in 1957 and shortly after, in 1958, the color of the herald was changed from orange to Daylight Red. However, no attempt was made to repaint the entire fleet of overnight cars. The silver "Overnights" paint scheme was seen into the late 1960s.

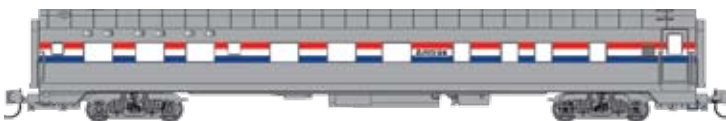

Amtrak Railroad Passenger Cars



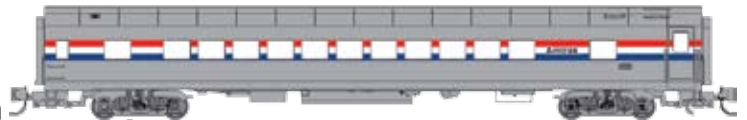
