Road Number **USLX 20983**



This three bay Evans covered hopper is painted gray with red and white logo and black lettering. It was built in March 1981 by Evans Products Co. and runs on Barber® Roller Bearing Trucks. Evans was a supplier of freight cars, parts, loading devices, and freight car kits. Prolific from 1966 until 1982, they built over 37,000 freight cars. An innovative company, their loading devices revolutionized how freight is shipped; they are primarily responsible for the development of the coil steel car design still being built today.

This 34' wood-sheathed caboose with straight cupola is painted box car red with black and white logo and white lettering. It was built in June 1938 and runs on swing motion caboose trucks. Caboose use has declined and seldom seen on trains, except on locals and smaller railroads. The caboose provided the train crew with a shelter at the rear of the train. They could exit the train for switching or to protect the rear of the train when stopped. The caboose provided minimal living quarters for longer trips. Caboose were non-revenue equipment and were often improvised or retained well beyond the normal lifetime of a freight car.



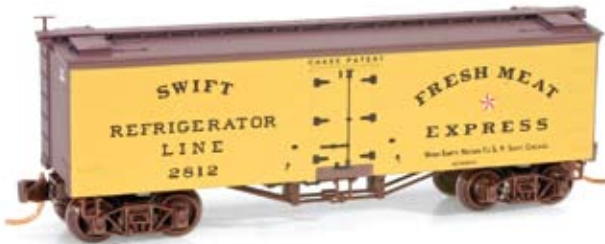

Swift Refrigerator Line
Road Number **2812**



This 36' wood-sheathed ice reefer is painted box car red with yellow sides. It bears a black "Fresh Meat Express" with red and white star logo. It was built in the late 1890s and runs on Arch Bar trucks. The reefer was not the invention of the railroads or meatpackers, but the result of inventive minds such as Gustavus Swift in the late 1800s. Swift began as a butcher's apprentice and rose to become one of the countries most prominent meat barons. When the reefers were introduced to the meat packing industry, they were instantly welcomed as a profitable alternative to shipping live animals in stock cars.

Nevada County Narrow Gauge Railroad
Road Number **155**



This 30' flat car with wood stack load is painted box car red with white lettering. It was originally built in 1900 by American Car & Foundry for Nevada-California-Oregon Railway. It runs on Bettendorf trucks. The Nevada County Narrow Gauge Railroad began operations 1876 to provide reliable year-round transportation to the rich mining districts of western Nevada County, CA. During sixty-six years of operation, it hauled out more than \$200,000,000 of gold while bringing in mining machinery, lumber, petroleum products and all of the essentials necessary to maintain the thriving county.

This GP-9 locomotive is painted white with black roof and catwalk and with red, white and blue stripes and black Amtrak logo. Lettering is black. An EMD GP9 is a 4-axle diesel locomotive built by General Motors Electro-Motive Division between January 1954 and August 1963. 3,436 examples of this locomotive model were built for American railroads. Power was provided by an EMD 567C sixteen-cylinder engine which generated 1,750 horsepower. Many rebuilt GP9s remain in service today with shortline railroads and industrial operators. Some remain in rebuilt form on some major Class I railroads, or as switcher locomotives.

New Hampshire State Car
Road Number NH 1788



This 40' Standard Box Car with plug door is Car #9 of a 50-car series representing each of the 50 states in the union. It bears the Purple Finch and Lilac flower, New Hampshire's official state bird and flower. The flag of the state of New Hampshire is in the background. The road number 1788 represents the year 'The Granite State' was admitted into the union.

Southern Pacific® / Santa Fe
Road Numbers 6533 / 2858



These GP-35 powered locomotives are painted red and yellow with black roof, red stripe and yellow lettering. SP 6533 was built as part of EMD order number 7695 for the Southern Pacific railroad in 1964; ATSF 2858 was built as part of EMD order number 7786-9 for the ATSF railroad in 1965 and originally wore the number 1358. They both wear SP/SF merger point scheme commonly called Kodachrome. In the early 1980s, locomotives from both the SP & ATSF were painted in this point scheme in anticipation of a merger between Southern Pacific and Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe. In 1985 the ICC denied the merger and the railroads began returning the locos to their standard paint.

These 70' Gunderson well cars are painted box car red with white logos and lettering. They were built by the Gunderson Company of Portland, OR and run on Roller Bearing trucks. The Husky-Stack® was a single well double-stack container car first introduced at the 1990 International Intermodal Expo in Atlanta, GA. The design allowed "cars" to be made up of single wells, or with simple modifications to be drawbar connected to create a multi-unit car.

These 50' standard box cars with double doors are painted McGinnis Orange with black sills; they bear black and white logos and are lettered in white. They were built in November 1956 by Pullman Standard and run on Bettendorf trucks. Only 15 double door cars were delivered to New Haven by Pullman Standard in November 1956. Series 40500-40514 came equipped with double Youngstown doors. Pullman Standard sold the remaining cars to the Chesapeake & Ohio complete with NH appliances.



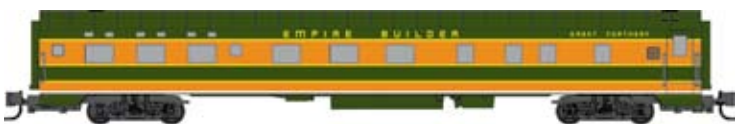

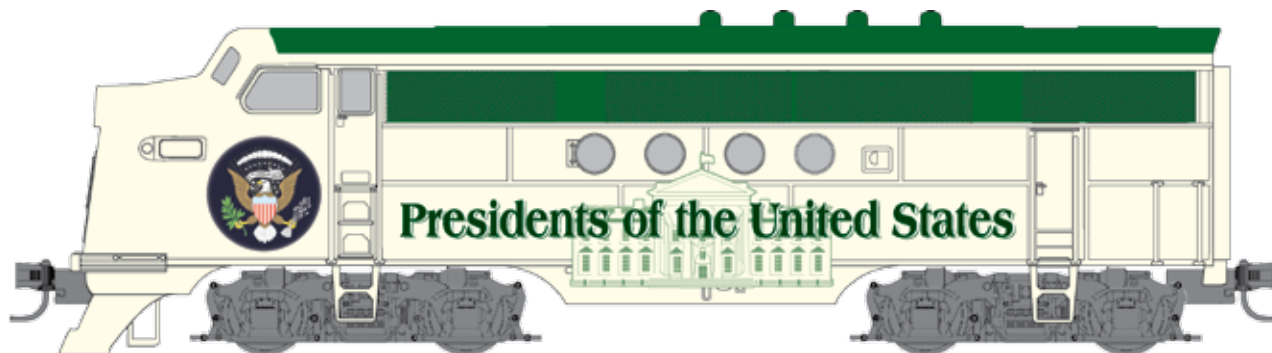

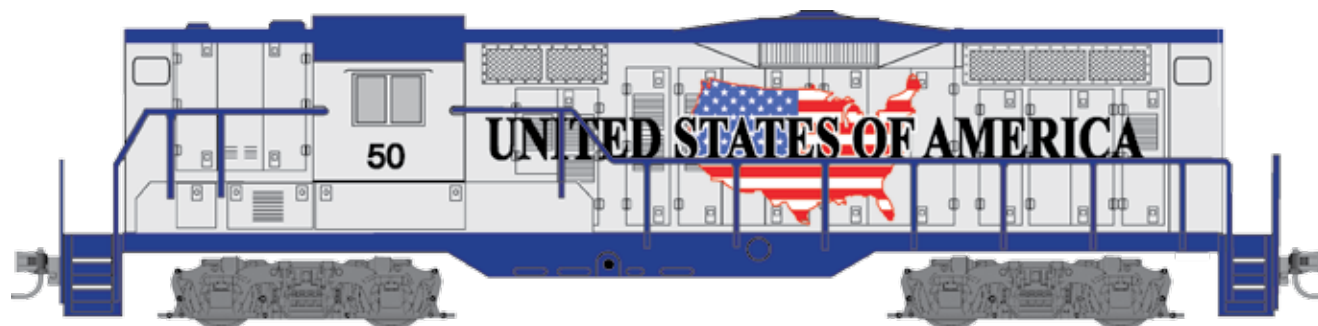
