Road Number **SP 500502 / 500516**



These heavyweight depressed center flat cars are painted box car red with white lettering. They were built in June 1958, serviced in January 1959 and runs on Buckeye trucks. The cars from this short series were built and originally run on the Texas & New Orleans R.R. (T&NO) in 1958 and numbered into series 19101-19120. Fifteen cars were brought over to the Southern Pacific and renumbered in January 1959. The final five of the new series were added in 1962.

**Canadian Northern**  
Road Number **CNR 16272**



This 36' wood sheathed ice reefer with modern steel underframe is painted box car red with white sides, black herald and side lettering, and white end lettering. It was built in 1910 by Cossens Car Manufacturing Company (CCMCo) of Coburg, Canada, and runs on arch bar trucks. The Canadian Northern Railway (CNoR), by the end of the teens, had become a constituent part of the Canadian National Railways which was formed in 1918. By the time this car was constructed the CNoR was the only customer of the CCMCo and in 1915 when Cossens closed its doors its final units were also destined for the CNoR.

**Chicago, Burlington & Quincy**  
Road Number **CB&Q 34236**



This 40' standard box car with single door and no roofwalk is painted green with white lettering. It was built in June 1945, serviced in August 1969, and runs on Bettendorf trucks. When the cars entered service as CB&Q #39675-40634, all were painted in the pre-merger Cascade Green paint scheme. The plan was to add the word NORTHERN below the BURLINGTON, but by the time the merger was consummated, the font had changed to a thinner style, so these cars never received the full merger name.

**William Henry Harrison Presidential Car**  
Road Number **1841-1841**



This 40' standard box car with plug door and no roofwalk is car #9 of a 44-car series representing each of the presidents of the United States. It bears the portrait of our ninth president, William Henry Harrison. The car comes with a commemorative pin replicated from that era. Harrison became the first president to die in office when he died of pneumonia 32 days after his inaugural celebration. Harrison's father signed the Declaration of Independence and his grandson became the 23rd president of the United States.

**Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe<sup>®</sup>**  
Road Number **ATSF 88099**



This 89' tri-level closed auto rack is painted red with blue placards and aluminum roof. Logos and lettering are in white; Excess Height message is in black. It was built in 1976, serviced in December 1978 and runs on Barber<sup>®</sup> Roller Bearing trucks. The first auto racks had exposed sides that led to vehicle damage from vandalism and weather; in the early 1970s the railroads started to enclose them with steel mesh. Tri-level racks continued to be used predominantly for automobiles, while the bi-level racks were primarily used for light trucks and vans. Auto Racks are one of the most commonly seen cars on the railroads today.

## Conrail Road Number CR 208875



This 50' standard box car with single door and no roofwalk is painted brown with white door. Lettering and logo are white. It was built in 1968 by Pullman Standard, serviced in December 1980 and runs on Barber® Roller Bearing trucks. Created in 1976, Conrail was the recipient of fleets of boxcars from its predecessors. #208875 is ex-Erie Lackawanna #63553, built as a general service boxcar by Pullman-Standard. #208875 Class BESOF has White doors designating commodities to be eaten, "FEED FOR LOADING ONLY".

## New York Central Road Number NYC 92102



This 50' standard box car with single door is painted light blue with black roof and ends. It displays a white and blue logo and white lettering. This car was built in May 1957 by American Car & Foundry, serviced in September 1958 and runs on Bettendorf trucks. Just two cars were assigned to Flinkote Company service (92101 & 92102), receiving this NYC experimental scheme of black roof and ends with unique blue point on sides and white lettering. A few months later, the NYC began painting their freight cars NYC Century Green. The "DF" initials on the door let the customer know this car offers damage free delivery of customer cargo.

## ADM Transportation Road Number ADMX 29867



This 56' general service tank car is painted black with white and blue logo and white lettering. It was built in November 1988 by American Car & Foundry of Milton, PA, and runs on Barber® Roller Bearing trucks. In November of 1988, ADM Transportation Company ordered 85 class 111-A-100-W-1 non-coiled/non-insulated tank cars built on Lot #18-14356. The primary difference between the various types of DOT-111-A-100 class tank cars is internal with varying types of insulation, lining and even weld material. Class W-1 types would generally carry such commodities as gasoline, or vegetable oils.

This 40' standard box car with plug door is car #11 of a 50-car series representing each of the 50 states in the union. It bears the Mountain Bluebird and Sagebrush, Nevada's official state bird and flower. The flag of the state of Nevada is in the background. The road number 1864 represents the year the 'Silver State' was admitted into the union.

**Montana Rail Link  
Road Numbers 401 / 402**



These GP-35 powered locomotives are painted blue and black with white stripes, red and black logo, and white lettering. It was built by the Electro-Motive Division of General Motors in 1964. They were built as part of EMD order number 4410 for the Detroit, Toledo & Ironton railroad in 1964, went to Grand Trunk Western, then Montana Rail Link (MRL). These locos wore the MRL blue with the "Flying W" and the numbers 401 and 402 until this "Lion's Head" paint scheme was applied in the late 1990s.

These 50' standard box cars with plug doors are painted brown with white "wet noodle" logos and lettering. They were built in January 1987, serviced in March 2003 and run on Roller Bearing trucks. The cars display the English "Canadian National" on the right side of the car, and French "Canadien National" on the left side. A note under the tack board indicates this car was used for paper service.

These 50' gondolas with fishbelly sides and 50' scrap loads are painted black with white logos and lettering. They were built in December 1996 and run on Roller Bearing trucks. These gondolas are specialty open top cars with fixed sides, fixed ends and solid bottom. They're equipped with steel cushion underframe and fabricated steel girders for coil steel.

**Alaska Railroad Passenger Cars**



These smoothside passenger were manufactured by Pullman Standard for Great Northern and ran the rails from the 1940s to the 1960s. Originally built for passenger luxury and comfort, many of these cars found their way into maintenance-of-way fleet bunk cars, private corporate and tourist fleet, as well as speed freight service.

## Rio Grande Southern® Road Number 7455



This 30' flat car is painted box car red with white lettering. It was built in 1910 and runs on Bettendorf trucks. Originally built for the Colorado and Southern as stock cars in the 1910, these cars were stripped down to their decks and used as flat cars on the Rio Grande Southern shortly after being acquired by that railroad in 1938. Today much of the former Rio Grande Southern rolling stock has new life in tourism, including Knott's Berry Farm railway.
