## Southern Pacific<sup>®</sup> Road Numbers SP 654812 / 654814



These 60' excess height box cars with double plug doors are painted brown with white logos and lettering, and white excess height markings. They were built in January 1979 by Benwick Forge and Fabricating and run on Roller Bearing trucks. These class BX-100-46 box cars came equipped with shock control, EOC Cushion underframe, plug doors and available steel floor.

## Wisconsin Southern Road Number WSOR 503052



This 50' standard box car with double doors and no roofwalk is painted brown with white log and lettering. The American Flag is painted right of the doors with the statement "Support Our Troops." It was built in 1971, serviced in October 2000, and runs on Roller Bearing trucks. This car follows a set of three repainted RBL box cars in remembrance of America's events of September 11, 2001, (dedicated in December of that year). The W&S applied their bright yellow vertical reflectors in early of 2006.

## Burlington Northern Road Number BN 446219



This 3 bay ACF Centerflow covered hopper with elongated hatches is painted green with white herald and lettering. It was built in June 1975 by American Car & Foundry of Huffington, WV and runs on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. It's a 4650 cubic foot grain hopper equipped with gravity outlets and through hatches.

## Abraham Lincoln Presidential Car Road Number 1861-1865



This 40' standard box car with plug door and no roofwalk is car #25 of a 44-car series representing each of the presidents of the United States. It bears the portrait of our 16th president, Abraham Lincoln. The car comes with a commemorative pin replicated from this era. A country lawyer who later became the nation's first Republican president, Lincoln successfully led his country through its greatest internal crisis, the American Civil War, preserving the Union and ending slavery. Days later he became the first American president to be assassinated.

## Ontario Northland Road Number ONT 5019



This 50' steel side, 14 panel fixed end gondola is painted blue with yellow log and white lettering. It was built in February 1967 by Hawker-Siddeley and runs on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. The large "Triple Lightning" herald is indicative of the businesses in which the Ontario Northland is engaged: Railroad and telecommunications, a natural outgrowth of the telegraph lines that were strung along the railroad's right-of-way, carrying CBC radio and video into the far North.

This 50' standard box car with double doors and no roofwalk is painted with reefer yellow sides, aluminum roof and freight car red ends. It is lettered in black with a black and white compass logo and the red and white Air-Pak logo. It was built in 1968 by American Car & Foundry, serviced in 1979, and runs on Roller Bearing trucks. This car displays the Air-Pak logo to advertise the internal Evans load divider installed in the car.

**Road Number CSXT 143203**

This 50' standard box car with single door and no roofwalk is painted blue yellow logo and lettering. It was built in September 1961, serviced in November 1989, and runs on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. On November 1, 1980, the Chessie System and Seaboard Coast Line Industries Inc. united and CSX Corporation was born.

**REPRINT** **Central Vermont**  
**Road Number CV 41115**

This 40' outside-braced box car with one and one-half doors is painted brown with white logo and lettering. It was built in March 1928 and runs on Andrews trucks. These box cars were considered a modern design for the time, saving space and weight—a very successful design that dominated the rails for half a century. While most of the outside braced cars were built for general service, some were built specifically to carry machinery and automobiles. The large 1-1/2 door opening on this car allowed for easier loading/unloading of automobiles.

This 40' despatch stock car is painted box car red with white logo and lettering. It was built in March 1947 and runs on Bettendorf trucks. New York Central converted 500 outside-braced box cars into stock cars. The new class 727-S cars were renumbered into the 28000-28499 series. In the rebuilding process, the diagonal braces were reversed from the original box car design.

This 40' Standard Box Car with plug door is car #27 of a 50-car series representing each of the 50 states in the union. It bears the Roadrunner and Yucca, New Mexico's official state bird and flower. The flag of the state of New Mexico is in the background. The road number 1912 represents the year the 'Land of Enchantment' was admitted into the union.

This black GP9 powered locomotive with red ends, white lettering and a large white 'wet noodle' CN logo was built by General Motors Diesel in 1957. The GMD GP9 is a 4-axle diesel locomotive built by General Motors Electro-Motive Division between January 1954 and August 1963. General Motors Diesel, Limited, was created in 1949 as the Canadian subsidiary of the Electro Motive Division of General Motors located in the United States.

These PS-2 covered hoppers are painted light gray with black and white herald and black lettering. It was built in April 1956 by Pullman-Standard, serviced in March 1981, and runs on Roller Bearing trucks. Special interior linings were given for sugar, grain and abrasive service. Around 1981, these hoppers were moved from their original series and placed into Maintenance of Way service for the Boston & Maine and remained in service through 2009.

This 40' standard box car with single door is painted black with aluminum sides. It bears Western Pacific's large orange feather emblem and is lettered in black with white end lettering. It was built in November 1951 by Pullman-Standard, serviced in February 1953, and runs on Bettendorf trucks. In 1951, WP ordered 600 PS-1 box cars from Pullman-Standard, numbered 20801-21400. The cars appeared in WP's standard paint scheme, a plain box car red with silver reporting marks and the square feather herald on the right side of the car. The second 22 cars were sent back to Pullman in 1953 to receive their Compartmentizers and were re-numbered into series 19521-19542. They were painted aluminum with black roof and ends and a large new orange feather emblem across the side and door.

This 40' standard box car with single door is painted aluminum with large orange feather emblem and black lettering. It was built in November 1951 by Pullman-Standard, serviced in 1952, and runs on Bettendorf trucks. In 1951, WP ordered 600 PS-1 boxcars from Pullman-Standard, numbered 20801-21400. The cars appeared in WP's standard paint scheme, a plain box car red with silver reporting marks and the square feather herald on the right side of the car. The first 20 cars however were re-numbered at Pullman in 1952 to 19501-19520. They had Compartmentizers added and were painted completely all-over aluminum with a large new orange feather emblem across the side and door.

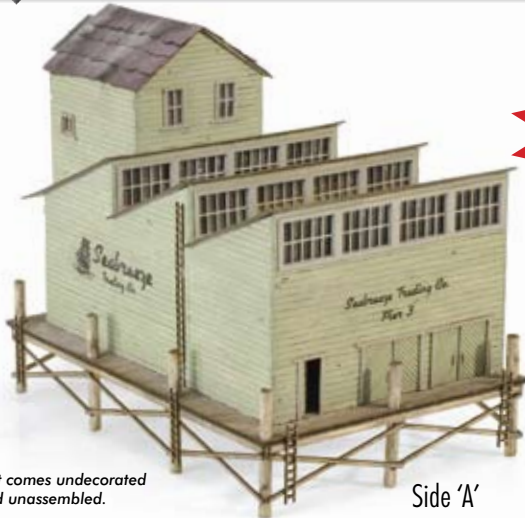

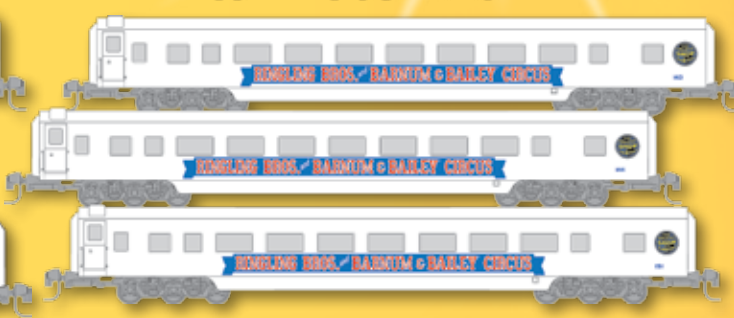
