NEW Paired Window Coach Car



This 78' Pullman heavyweight paired-window coach car is painted Pullman Green with 'PULLMAN' letters across the top in metallic gold. It was built based on Pullman Plan B&O #2882-B in the 1930s and runs on six-wheel passenger trucks. This car was one of the typical coach styles that served many of the passenger car fleets as early as the 1930s. Not only could they be found in both local and regional trains, but these cars lasted long into the era of Lightweight Passenger Cars and many went on to serve a variety of roles including commuter and MOW service.

This Pullman heavyweight paired-window coach car, based on the Baltimore & Ohio Plan #2882-B, is painted SP Daylight Olive Green with the 'SOUTHERN PACIFIC LINES' lettering centered across the top in metallic gold. The road number is also lettered in metallic gold. This coach ran from the 1930s through the 1960s and run in six-wheel passenger trucks. Not only could they be found in both local and regional trains, but these cars lasted long into the era of lightweight passenger cars and many went on to serve a variety of roles including commuter and MOW service.

This 61' 8" bulkhead flat car w/load is painted brown with white herald and lettering. It was built in November 1972 by the Thrall Car Company of Chicago Heights, IL, and runs on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. Bulkhead flat cars were very popular for carrying lumber and other wood products. Southern Railway came into existence in 1894 through the combination of the Memphis and Charleston Railroad, the Richmond and Danville system and the East Tennessee, Virginia and Georgia Railroad.

This three-bay Centerflow[®] covered hopper with elongated hatches is painted light gray with black logo and lettering. The built date is unknown, but the service date is 2006. This hopper runs on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. WSOR covered hoppers with the 501100 series numbers are assigned to the task of transporting sand from the Badger Mining pit at Utley, WI, to end users across the nation, and are generally given the benefit of a coat of gray paint with the black WSOR lettering. MRMX is Midwest Railcar Corporation and appears to be a railcar leasing company.

This three-bay Centerflow[®] covered hopper with elongated hatches is painted gray with black logo and lettering. It was built in March 1977 by American Car & Foundry and runs on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. This cylindrical design reduced maintenance, by eliminating pockets, corners and protrusions where product could accumulate, and was favored for the shipment of grains, salt and granular chemicals. These cars were built with an interior lining, adding protection for both the car and the load it carried.

This 50' U.S. Army kitchen car is painted Pullman Green marked with red crosses on white on the sides and roof. A caduceus flanks the side of the door. It was built between 1943 and 1946 by American Car & Foundry in Chicago, IL, and runs on Allied Full Cushion trucks. Upon America's entry into the war in late 1941, Defense Plant Corporation contracted with American Car & Foundry for 800 troop kitchen cars and 40 hospital cars. They were operated by Pullman Company and assigned to the Transportation Corps or Medical Department of the Army Service Forces.

Theodore Roosevelt Presidential Car Road Number 1901-1909



This 40' standard box car with plug door and no roofwalk is car #39 of a 44-car series representing each of the presidents of the United States. It bears the portrait of our 26th president, Theodore Roosevelt. The car comes with a commemorative pin replicated from this era. In 1901, after the assassination of W. McKinley Roosevelt became the youngest President in U.S. history at age 42.

This 60' excess height box car is painted brown with white herald and lettering. Each end bears the white excess height markings with black print. It was built in November 1978 and runs on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. This box car was part of a 4-car series 37562-37565 equipped with nailable steel floors, DF belts, and shock control. It was assigned to auto parts transport.

These 61' 8" bulkhead flat cars with loads are painted green with white logos and lettering. They were built in April 1976 by the Thrall Car Company of Chicago Heights, IL, and run on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. Bulkhead flat cars were very popular for carrying lumber and other wood products. Burlington Northern Railroad was the product of a 1970 merger comprising the Great Northern Railway; Northern Pacific Railway; Chicago, Burlington and Quincy Railroad; and the Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway.

This 40' standard box car with plug door is car #41 of a 50-car series representing each of the 50 states in the union. It bears the Orange Blossom and Mockingbird, Florida's official state flower and bird. The flag of the state of Florida is in the background. The road number 1845 represents the year the 'Sunshine State' was admitted into the union.

These SD40-2 powered locomotives are painted gray with blue and yellow bands and gray roofs. The cabs and decks are blue, the nose and rear end is yellow, and the printing is blue and yellow. They loco were built in 1979 by Electro Motive Division as part of order #786287 for the L&N, later acquired by SBD, then CSXT. These locos retained their original numbers even when they changed reporting marks and paint. The paint scheme they wear was seen from 1992 through 2000, when cab roofs began to be painted gray, with a few locos wearing it as late as 2002.

This 50' rib side box car with single door and no roofwalk is painted CP Action Red with white logo and lettering, as well as yellow reflectors. The service date is October 1995 and runs on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. The CPAA reporting marks mean these cars are assigned to international service, moving parts between plants in the United States and Canada.

**Western Pacific®

These 60' bulkhead flat cars are painted black with white logos and lettering. They were built in January 1978 and run on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. The Western Pacific® Railroad was formed in 1903 as an attempt to break the near-monopoly the Southern Pacific® Railroad had on rail service into Northern California. WP's Feather River Route directly competed with SP's portion of the Overland Route for rail traffic between Salt Lake City/Ogden, UT and Oakland, CA, for nearly 80 years. In 1983, the Western Pacific was acquired by the Union Pacific Railroad®.

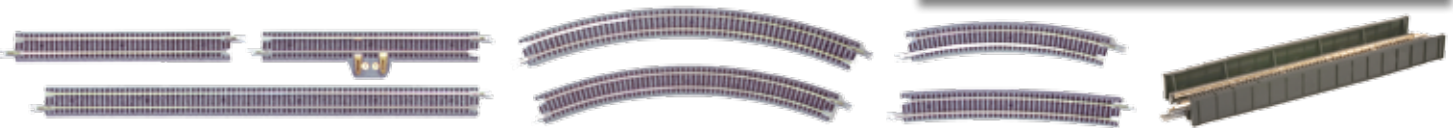

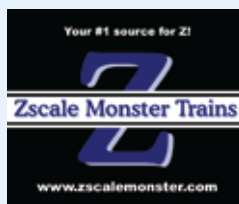
