

Baltimore & Ohio[®] Road Name Lake Superior



This 83' Heavyweight 10-1-2 Sleeper is painted with the black roof, blue body and gray sides paint scheme. It's lettered in Dulux Gold with the road name Lake Superior and inside is gray seating. It was built in January 1924 by Pulman Standard and air conditioning added in August 1934. The car runs on six-wheel passenger trucks. The Baltimore & Ohio Heavyweight '10-1-2' Sleepers (10 Section-1 Drawing Room-2 Compartment Sleeper) were built from the Pullman Plan #3585. Pullman's Heavyweight construction was modular, making it possible for floor plans to economically evolve with the times. Cars were cenerally in service thru the 1960s.

Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Road Numbers ATSF 37562 / 37565



These 60' excess height box cars with double plug doors and waffle sides is painted box car red with white excess height end masks. The lettering, as well as the 1989 gothic ATSF herald with Santa Fe circle/cross logo, is white. They were built in November 1978 by Berwick Forge and Fabricating, serviced in August 1989, and runs on Roller Bearing trucks. They are class BX-187 box cars equipped with fixed end bulkheads and shock control underframe, assigned to auto parts service.

Canadian Pacific Road Name Redvers



This 83' Heavyweight 10-1-2 Sleeper is painted Candian Pacific maroon with Canadian Pacific and the road name Redvers in Dulux Imitation Gold. Interior seating in this sleeper is MOW green and it runs on six-wheel passenger trucks. It was built by Canadian Car & Foundry in Montreal in May 1929 and ran through the 1980s on the CP Trans-Canada limited

Soo Line Road Number SOO 63352



This 50' steel side 14-panel fixed end gondola is painted white with red SOO LINE herald and black lettering. It was built by Thrall Car Manufacturing in December 1976 and runs on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. B63352 was often seen hauling its freight with the distinctive white and red scheme that became a familiar sight system-wide. This series consisted of 200 cars, but Soo Line continued to increase their gondola fleet and they were seen on the rails for many years..

This 36' wood-sheathed ice reefer with modern underframe is painted brown with reefer yellow sides, multi-colored Honey Brand logo, Hams Bacon Lard Produce, and a red and black logo. Side lettering is black and end lettering is white. The reefer was built in 1925 by Pressed Steel Car Company of Hegewisch, IL, and runs on Bettendorf trucks. This reefer is one of a group of 150 refrigerator cars constructed for the North American Car Company's leasing company, North American Despatch. The cars from this series displayed many different billboard themes, advertising for the company leasing them from N.A.D.X.

Chesapeake & Ohio[®] Road Number C&O 18719



This 40' standard box car with single sliding Superior door and roowalk is painted black with white logo and lettering. It was built in June 1952 by Pullman Standard, serviced in December 1961, and runs on Bettendorf trucks. #18719 was from the second part of a 1,000-car order delivered to the C&O. In 1961, at the Wyoming Shops in Grand Rapids, MI, C&O painted this box car in a black scheme indicating it was used for specialized service or was specially equipped inside.




This 50' flat car with fishbelly side and side mount brake wheel carries a tank load. It's painted brown with a white Conrail 'can opener'logo and white lettering. It was built in August 1959 and runs on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. Conrail acquired these flat cars when they assimilated struggling roads such as Penn Central Transporation Company and Lackawana Railway in 1976. They were repainted into Conrail colors in 1977 and served many years of hard service under the Conrail name.

21400; it appeared at that time in WP's standard paint scheme—plain box car red with silver reporting marks square feather herald on the right side of the car. It was sent back to Pullman Standard in 1953 to receive its compartmentizer, re-numbered into series 19521-19542, and re-painted aluminum with a new large orange feather emblems.

Detroit, Toledo & Ironton **Road Number DTI 9505**



This 50' steel side 15-panel fixed end gondola with low cover is painted black with large yellow DT&I letters, and white and yellow compass logo. Side lettering is in yellow and end print is black. It was built in August 1969, serviced in March 1972, and runs on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. This 10-car series came from Greenville Steel Car Company with their covers and when received were specially equipped with internal bulkheads to haul skids of cut steel blanks. In addition to the covers, these cars came fitted with FreightMaster end-of-car cushioning devices and had wood floors. The lids and ends of these gondolas were painted bright yellow so the crane operator would attach the correct lid to the matching gondola after unloading.

Western Maryland Road Numbers 238 / 408



These Western Maryland F7 locos are painted black with yellow stripe and 'Western Maryland' lettering. Both were built in 1952 by EMD. F7 'A' unit was part of order #3068-A. It was later renumbered to 7172 and turned in to EMD in 1977. F7 'B' unit was part of order #3068-B and first numbered 235B. Sometime later it was renumbered to 7142 and turned in to EMD in 1978.

These 33' twin bay open hoppers are painted light box car red. In 1931, the Standard Steel Car Co. built 500 all-steel hopper cars for the Great Northern. These two hopper paint schemes are within the same road series and were seen in service together. Repairs and repainting at different times over the years account for variations. The GN used hoppers in revenue loading of coal, manganese and zinc concentrates, iron ore, bauxite, sand gravel, crushed rock and sugar beets.

Grand Trunk Western Road Number GTW 598093



This 50' rib side box car with plug doors is painted GTW Burdakin blue with aluminum roof and bears white lettering. It runs on black Barber Roller Bearing trucks. It was built in November of 1979 by the National Steel Car Company, in Hamilton, Canada. The GTW, a leading carrier of finished automobiles, links Detroit with Chicago. A 1980 merger with the Detroit, Toledo & Ironton RR gave the GTW a route from Detroit to Cincinnati, as well.

Utah State Car Road Number UT 1896



This 40' Standard Box Car with plug door is car #47 of a 50-car series representing each of the 50 states in the union. It bears the Sego Lily and California Gull, Utah's official state flower and bird. The flag of the state of Utah is in the background. The road number 1896 represents the year the 'Beehive State' was admitted into the union.


New York Central Road Number NYC 176144



This 50' standard box car with single door is painted black with green sides and runs on black roller bearing trucks. It was originally built by the Despatch Shops at East Rochester, New York in 1941 as part of a 11000 car fleet, this car was serviced in April of 1959 and repainted in this scheme of Century green sides with black ends and roof, and white lettering. The large white, black and red 'cigar band' logo decorates the left side.




