The EMD SW1500 was General Motors upgrade of the successful SW1200 and provided it's customers with a larger, more powerful switcher for their yard services. Powered by the EMD 645 Diesel Electric engine, the SW1500 found a home on most major class 1 railroads and went on to work on short lines and industrial customers. A total of 808 units were produced between 1967 and 1968 and operated on lines from Canada and Mexico.

Our N scale model will come with separate handrails, bell and horns, window inserts, operating headlight, body mounted Magne-Matic[®] couplers and fine surface detail. Initial releases will be equipped with AAR style trucks and decorated in the accurate prototypical paint schemes. Pre-orders begin next month!

These 65′ 100-Ton Log Cars are painted green with white lettering and ride on 100-Ton Trucks with 36″ wheels. The cars were built by Evans Car Company in the 1980's and found service with many companies transporting logs, pulpwood and other lumber products. Georgia-Pacific originally used horse drawn carriages in the 1920's to transport logs, but with the use of log cars like these, has grown to be a leader in the production of tissue, pulp, paper, packaging and other building products.

These are 100 ton PS-2 three bay covered hoppers, painted green, with white logos and lettering. They were built by Pullman Standard as part of lot 9532 in March 1971 and run on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. The Burlington Northern was created on March 2, 1970, by the merger of four primary railroads: Chicago, Burlington & Quincy, Northern Pacific, Great Northern, and the Spokane, Portland & Seattle.

This 50' standard box car with double Youngstown doors in painted a simulated UP Synthetic Red with the 'Serves all the West' slogan in yellow and lettering in white. This A-50-14 class box car was built in 1937 then serviced in July 1944. The car was a 1937 Association of American Railroads design with a 5/5 Dreadnaught end; running boards were wood, typical of pre-war built freight cars. The car runs on Bettendorf trucks.

Smithsonian Civil War Series Car #11: Surrender at Appomatiox



The final battle between General Lee's Confederate Army and Lt. General Grant's Union Army was fought on April 9, 1865. General Lee hoped to rejoin his Confederate forces in North Carolina, but was cut off by the Union Army and was forced to make his last stand at Appomattox Court House. Unable to break through the Union line, Lee surrendered his Confederate Army. The surrender documents were signed on April 12th, marking the official end of the war.

Gluek Brewing Road Number NRC 3353



This 40' wood sheathed reefer with vertical brake wheel is the third offering in the Brewery Reefer Series. This release represents the Gluek Brewing Company of Minneapolis, MN. A successful brewery, it was turning out 44 barrels of beer a day. The brewery survived Prohibition, but was eventually sold to G. Heilemann in 1964. He tore the place down two years later. The Gluek's label was acquired by the Cold Spring Brewing Company, which today produces beer for the Gluek's restaurant in downtown Minneapolis.

This 50' standard box car with plug and sliding door and no roofwalk is painted green with the BCR dogwood logo and white herald and lettering. It was built in August 1972 and runs on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. In 1984, British Columbia Railway was reorganized and renamed BC Rail.

This 50' rib side box car, single door with no roofwalk is painted blue with black sliding door; it bears white lettering and herald. It was built by FMC of Portland, OR, in September 1979 and runs on Roller Bearing trucks. The class XM boxcar is assigned to paper service, not general use. This model represents the 1970s outside braced FMC cars that were designed to last longer. The specifications featured a beefed-up frame, and seamless interiors (to prevent vermin infestation). They clear plate C which means the cars have a maximum height of 15'6". Many were equipped with cushioned underframes and had received colorful paint schemes while under private ownership.

This standard box car with double doors came from NP's search for more of these cars styles in order to help handle the lumber traffic between 1961 and 1963. It was built in February 1945, serviced in November 1962, and runs on Bettendorf trucks. #38268 is one of many NP acquisitions that were castoff by Erie and Delaware, Lackawanna & Western railroads, and leased through A.A. Morrison Company of Buffalo, NY. All the leased cars were given this lettering scheme represented. The 500-car fleet wears the 3'6" red, black and white herald above the reporting mark, left of the door, with the arched road name to the right.



On January 1, 1981, CN bought out CPR's share in the NAR system and incorporated these lines into the CN network, allowing CN to operate unhindered north from Edmonton to Hay River, Northwest Territories, and west to Dawson Creek, British Columbia. NAR disappeared as a corporate entity with the departure of CPR from the joint ownership. NAR shops and Dunvegan Yords in Edmonton were demolished and the new Dunvegan Woods housing development was built on the site.
