Roseburg Lumber Road Numbers FURX 710014 / 710140



These 65' log cars are painted blue with red and white logos and white lettering. They have unknown built dates, likely the 1970s, and run on 100-ton Barber Roller Bearing trucks. The cars were built by Evans Car Company in the 1980's and found service with many companies transporting logs, pulpwood and other lumber products.

Milwaukee Road Road Name "Marquette"



This 83' Pullman heavyweight sleeper 10-1-2 is painted orange with maroon bands on the letterboards. The herald is lettered in metallic gold as well as the rest of the lettering. The roof, undframe and trucks are brown. This sleeper was built in 1911 as the 'Orleans', rebuilt in 1927 as the 'Marquette', and scrapped in 1949. The builder was Pullman-Standard. The introduction of the steel cars brought the end of the luxurious, artisan-crafted wooden cars which had been the rule since the 1880s. With the opening of the Pennsylvania Station in New York in 1910, and the Grand Central Terminal in 1913, passenger safety in the tunnels approaching these buildings demanded a more noncombustible material.

Union Pacific[®] Road Numbers UP 369048



This 50' rib side box car with double doors, short ladders and no roofwalk is painted synthetic red with red, white and blue UP shield and white lettering. It bears no built or service dates but ran from the early 1970s to mid-1980s. This Plate C designated box car ran as a A-100-15 by UP on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. As America's first transcontinental railroad, the UP was a major factor in taming the west with 2000 miles of main lines.

Built in 1913 and numbered into series 9900-9924, this beer reefer was serviced and repainted in December 1933. One side of the car advertises "Highland Beer" and the other side displays "Schotts Lager". It was leased through General American Refrigerator Express.

Seaboard System Road Numbers SBD 111935



This 50' box car with single door is painted black with yellow and red logo and yellow lettering. We have no built date but show a service date of September 1985. The car runs on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. The Seaboard System Railroad, Inc., was a short-lived former US Class I railroad that was created after the consolidation of the Family Lines System railroads on December 29, 1982. Under the Family Lines era, the railroads shared common ownership but used different names when conducting business. On July 1, 1986, the Seaboard System renamed itself as the CSX Transportation.

This two-bay Centerflow covered hopper with round hatches is painted light gray with black reporting marks and dim data. It was built in July 1980 by American Car & Foundry and runs the midwest on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. The design of this hooper is more compact than the cylindrical car style. They have a LO classification, four 30-inch round hatches and two gravity outlets, a 2700 cubic foot capacity and an interior length of 32-foot 1-inches. The tall design with rounded roof allows for a "fuller fill" and fewer voids or empty spaces.

NEW Pacific Great Eastern
Road Number PGE 261



This 33' twin bay hopper with offset side is painted brown with black and white logo, white reporting marks and lettering. It was built in October 1956 and ran trans-Canada in the 1950s on Roller Bearing trucks. The Pacific Great Eastern Railway (PGE), was a railway that operated in the Canadian province of British Columbia. It was a class II regional railway and the third-largest in Canada, eventually operating 1,441 miles of mainline track. It was owned by the provincial government starting in 1918, became British Columbia Railway (BCR) in 1972, and BC Rail (BCR) in 1984. In 2004 the operations were sold to the Canadian National Railway.

This 40' High-Cube box car is painted dark green with the white, black and red Northern Pacific Monad herald. Lettering is in white. It was built in November 1967 and runs on Roller Bearing trucks. The high-cube box cars were used primarily for appliance traffic.

This 50' rib side box car with single door and no roofwalk is painted brown with yellow door and white logo and lettering. It has an unknown built date but displays a service date of September 1981. It runs on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. Conrail is a governmental organization operated by the United States Railway Administration (USRA). Shortly after Penn Central went bankrupt in 1970, Congress created the United States Railway Administration (USRA) to plan a reorganization of the railroad and to act as its banker. The result was Consolidated Rail Corporation (abbreviated ConRail, then to Conrail).

**Canadian Pacific
Road Numbers 1400 / 1900**



Built by GMD as FP7A 4099 in 1953, this F7 was renumbered to CP 1400 in 1954. Sold to VIA Rail Canada (Canadian National's passenger subsidiary) in 1978, she became VIA 1400, then was renumbered to VIA 6550 in 1981. She was sold to Nebkota Railway in 1994, and renumbered 55. Canadian Pacific repatriated her in 1998, and repainted into the 1950's Maroon/Grey paint scheme and numbered CP 1400.

**Canadian Pacific
Road Number 5609**



This 40' double sheathed wood reefer with vertical brake wheel is painted maroon with black roof and ends. The 'Canadian Pacific' herald and lettering are all in Dulux imitation gold. Ladders and grabs are black—no door hardware. #5609 was one of a series of 100 express refrigerator cars built by Canadian Car & Foundry in June of 1922 and serviced in March 1955. The car runs on Bettendorf trucks.

**Southern Pacific®
Road Numbers 60166 / 60190**



These 39' single dome tank cars are painted black with white herald and lettering. They were built in March 1942 by Great American Transportation Corporation (GATCO), serviced in July 1962, and run the Central Western District on Bettendorf trucks. Headquartered in San Francisco, CA, the Southern Pacific had over 11,000 miles of railway from Chicago, south to New Orleans, and west to San Francisco and Portland, OR. On August 9, 1988, the ICC approved the sale of the SP to Rio Grande Industries. The new system was named Southern Pacific Lines. SP & UP merged Sept. 11, 1996.

**WWII 'Surprise'

This 60' Flat Car is painted Olive Drab with white lettering and carries a 40' gray container featuring 'Surprise Attack' art. Like many planes in WWII, this B-24 bomber was decorated with custom artwork by its pilot to personalize the plane. The 'Surprise Attack' B-24 bomber was part of the 14th Air Force, the 308th Bomb Group and 374th Squadron. The original panel displaying this art is at the American Airpower Heritage Museum in Midland, TX.

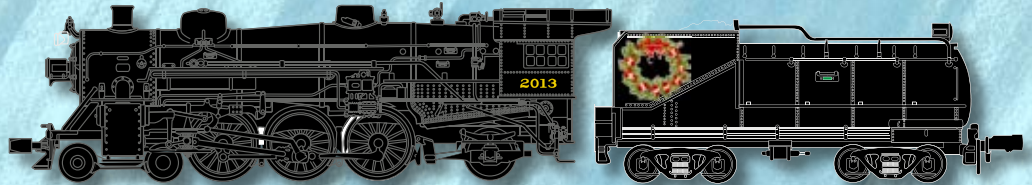

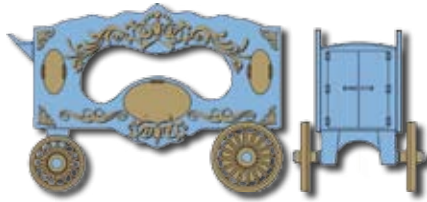

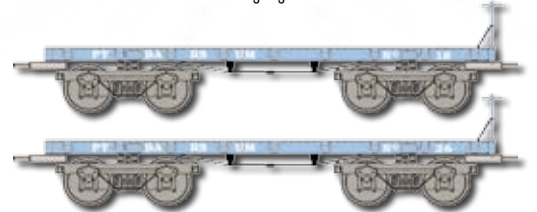

Retro Milwaukee Road Hydroframe 60 Single Door Box Cars



Milwaukee Road Rd #2150 repaint
Car #2150 which is the 100,000th Pullman-Standard PS-1 Box Car built originally had graphics to the right of the door indicating this achievement. Prior to entering revenue service the graphics were repainted. This was one of the first cars equipped with cushion under-frames, in this case the Hydroframe 60. This was the only car to be painted in a very light glittering gold paint.



Milwaukee Road Rd #2151
Milwaukee Road #2151 is from lot #8667 with RD # series 2150 through 2159 XL. Unlike Rd #2150 which had the glittering light metallic gold paint, Rd #2151 was painted in bright yellow with black ends, roof, door and new style Milwaukee graphics. It had the Hydroframe 60 cushion underframes.



Milwaukee Road Rd #2159
Milwaukee Road #2159 which was also from lot #8667 has been repainted years later. It has lost it's black ends and roof and door. the Milwaukee Road logo has also been placed in a slightly different location.
