This 3-2 heavyweight observation car is two-tone green with white lettering and runs on 6-wheel passenger trucks. Northern Pacific rebuilt a number of heavyweight cars in the 1950s into business cars which served as a rolling office for company officials and management. These cars continued to serve NP through the mid-1960s.

## Southern Road Number 22



This 3-2 heavyweight observation car is pullman green with gold lettering and runs on 6-wheel passenger trucks. Built in 1903 by CNO&TP, this observation car was rebuilt in 1939 with air conditioning by Southern Railway. The car included two state rooms, a kitchen and dining rooms.

#### Rock Island Road Number 92000



This heavyweight depressed-center flat car is brown with white lettering and runs on 6-wheel commonwealth freight trucks. Rock Island only had a single depressed center flat car, the RI 92000. Built in 1954 by RI from General Steel Castings components, this car was used for the transport of bulky and heavy industrial loads, such as electrical transformers and construction equipment.

#### New York Central Road Number 87228



This 40' standard box car with single door is black and green with white lettering and runs on Bettendorf trucks. As a part of NYC series 87222-87271, this appliance boxcar was specially equipped with SL load restraints. Built in 1956, it was among one of the last 40' box cars built for NYC as railroads moved to larger, higher capacity cars in the 1960s.

#### Monarch Foods Road Number NWX 14290



This 40' double-sheathed wood reefer with vertical brake wheel is grey with decorated sides and runs on Bettendorf trucks. Featuring a large produce mural for Reid, Murdoch & Company's "Monarch Finer Foods" brand, this reefer was assigned a North Western Refrigerator Line reporting mark and served through the 1930's.

#### HEINZ<sup>®</sup> Road Number HPFL 3015



This 36' wood sheathed ice reefer with truss rods is brown with yellow decorated sides and runs on Arch Bar trucks. With a fleet of 700 cars, HEINZ was able to ship their product by rail to major markets throughout the US. These yellow sided refrigerator cars represent railcars painted throughout the late 1900s and through the 'teens'. All cars carried the distinctive "Heinz 57" but each car advertised a different product.

#### Western Pacific® Road Number WP 14081



This 40' double sheathed wood box car with 1-1/2 door, and vertical brakewheel is brown with white lettering and runs on Bettendorf trucks. Built in 1923 by the Mount Vernon Car Manufacturing Company, this 3666 cubic foot wood sheathed door-and-a-half boxcar belonged to series 14001-14100. Used for auto parts service until the 1950s, this car's extra door on each side helped facilitate loading and unloading bulky components.

#### Soo Line Road Number 28354



This 40' double sheathed wood box car with 1-1/2 door, and vertical brakewheel is brown with white lettering and runs on Arch Bar trucks. Built in 1910 by ACF in Chicago, this 2400 cubic foot capacity wood-sheathed door-and-a-half boxcar had a 10'-6" opening that helped facilitate loading and unloading bulky auto parts and components. Retired by the 1950s, these cars were replaced by larger steel side auto parts boxcars.

#### Union Pacific® Road Number UP 170571



This 40' double sheathed wood box car with 1-1/2 door, and vertical brakewheel is brown with white lettering and runs on Bettendorf trucks. Built in 1917 by the Ralston Steel Car Company, this 3739 cubic foot capacity wood-sheathed door-and-a-half boxcar had a 10'-6" opening that helped facilitate loading and unloading bulky auto parts and components. Retired by the 1950s, these cars were replaced by larger steel side auto parts boxcars.

#### Norfolk Southern Road Number NS 465682



This 60' excess height box car with double plug doors and rivet sides is brown with white lettering and runs on Barber Roller Bearing trucks. Built by Thrall in April 1969, this double-plug door boxcar was built for N&W before later becoming part of Norfolk Southern series 465600-465853. At 7000 cubic feet, this hi-cubic capacity car was used to carry lightweight but bulky commodities such as auto parts.




## Frisco Road Numbers 325/351



These SW1500 powered locomotives are reddish/orange with white band and run on AAR trucks. From the late 1960s to the early 1970s the St. Louis-San Francisco Railway enlisted 46 EMD sourced SW1500s, painting them in Mandarin orange and white. These switchers could be found at all of Frisco's major yards until September 1980 when they were taken over by the Burlington Northern system.

Upgrades included electrical, crew amenity and headlight improvements. Many continued to serve in this paint scheme through the 2000s, even after SP was merged into UP in 1996.




